

- Concept Study in 2011
- Field Check Design in the KDOT TWORKS program stopped in 2015

I-70 Polk Quincy from MacVicar to 6th Street

- Selected for Development Pipeline "IKE" Eisenhower Legacy Transportation Program 2020
- Selected for Construction Pipeline "IKE" Eisenhower Legacy Transportation Program 2021
- Viaduct bridge condition prioritized the west project for selection
- KDOT did a maintenance project on the existing viaduct in 2023 to keep it operating short term







Construction Schedule





- Downtown access via I-70 from MacVicar to Topeka Boulevard at all times
 - Provides access to downtown from the West
 - Helps reduce detour traffic through City streets on MacVicar and 6th Street
- I-70 thru traffic will be detoured to I-470 at the beginning of the project
- I-70 closure is minimized to Year 2
 - Closure from early spring to late fall of 2026
 - Eastbound I-70 lanes open first with head-to-head traffic
- Investigating innovative approach to project bidding to minimize closure time and traffic impacts






Detour for EB I-70 Traffic to K-4








Demolition Project





- KDOT March 2022 Letting
- Buildings demolished starting in September 2022
- Allows Kansas State Historic Preservation Office investigation to be completed
- Jackson Street to remain open throughout
- Completed by the end of 2024

- A few remain in the acquisition process








Sidewalks/ Shared Use Paths Bike Lanes
